Western Minerals proposes to temporary abandon this well.

A 5.5" cement retainer will be set 50' above the Pictured Cliffs top and the casing will be tested to 500 PSI. The casing will be pressure tested every two years to 500 PSI.

This well was shut in 2005 when the PC zone was completed in the Marron #6 well. This well could be deepened to the Chacra formation to replace the marginal Snodgrass #1 well (30-045-22775). Or the Marron #1 could replace the Marron #6 well (30-045-21323) if it developes mechanical problems.
