COP proposes to deepen this well into the Pictured Cliffs to improve operating conditions for the Fruitland Coal. Currently the Drillers total depth for the SJ 32-7 Unit 203A was 3387'. COP would like to drill an additional 150' to gain access to another 3-4' coal string and then add a small sump below that seam. The new TD will be approx. of 3537'. We do not believe that the Pictured Cliffs is productive in the area without fracture stimulation, but we will utilize a mudlogger to monitor liberated gas while drilling the sump.
