Burlington Resources proposes to construct a new drilling pit, an associated vent/flare pit and a pre-set mud pit (if required). Based on Burlington's interpretation of the Ecosphere's risk ranking criteria, the new drilling pit and pre-set mud pit will be lined pits as detailed in Burlington's Revised Drilling / Workover Pit Construction / Operation Procedures dated November 11, 2004 on file at the NMOCD office. A portion of the vent/flare pit will be designed to manage fluids and that portion will be lined as per the risk ranking criteria.
