Black Hills Gas Resources has abandoned the Pictured Cliffs in this well. The workover rig was moved in on 6-12-08, the RBP previously set @ 1500' was removed. The perforated intervals were tested. Verbal approval obtained from Steve Mason 6-17-08 to abandon the Pictured Cliffs and Ojo Alamo intervals. A cement retainer was set @ 3704', 36.5 cu ft cement was placed on top of the retainer. A CIBP was set @ 3180'. Release rig 6-19-08. The well will be produced as a Tertiary-only well.
