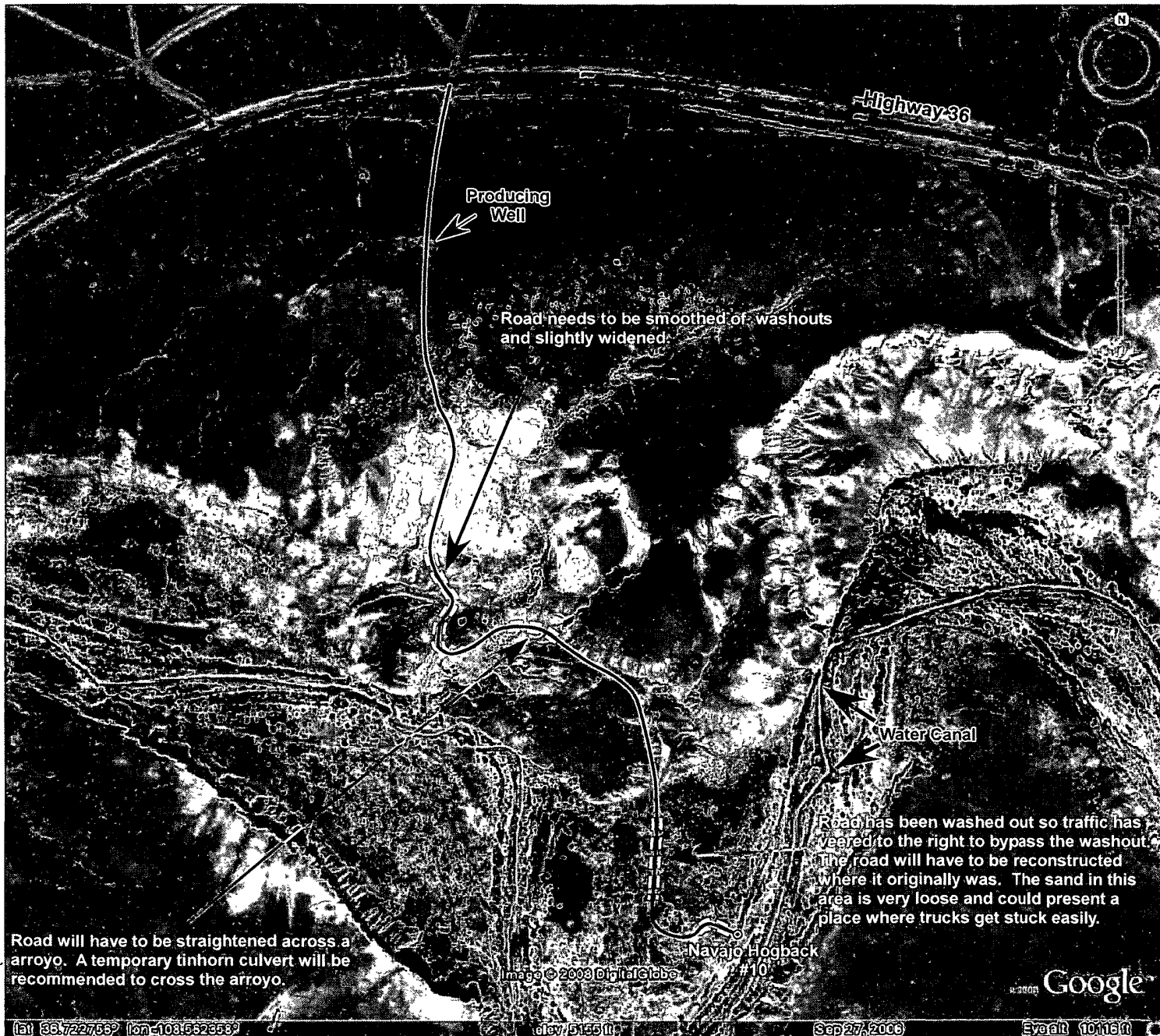

3. Install and test BOP
4. RU Power Swivel and Pump and drill out 4 3/4" casing to 390' (50' below 6 5/8" casing).
5. Run Bond Log to check for cement in annulus of 4 3/4" and 6 5/8" casings.
6. Perforate at 380' and squeeze 50 sks. Cement displacing to 280'.
7. WOC.
8. Tag cement, perforate at 280' and squeeze 50 sks. Cement displacing to 180'.
9. WOC.
10. Tag cement, perforate at 180' and squeeze 100 sks. Cement leaving casing full.
