

13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

It is intended to plug and abandon the existing Mesaverde formation and add pay to the Lewis formation in the subject well according to the following:

1. MIRU. Unseat pump and POOH with rods and pump.
2. ND wellhead, NU BOP and pull tubing.
3. RU wireline and RIH with CIBP and set at 4850' (top Mesaverde perforation at 4888'). Pressure test CIBP to 500 psi.
4. PU dump bailer and RIH on wireline to dump bail 35' of cement on top of CIBP to P&A the existing Mesaverde perforations.
5. RIH on wireline and perforate the Lewis from 4370'-4790'.
6. Fracture stimulate the Lewis with 75 quality nitrogen foam and 200,000#'s Arizona sand
7. RIH with tubing and clean out to cement cap.
8. Land production tubing and RD.
