10/31/08 P&A'd this well as follows: Set a 4-1/2" cement retainer at 1374' KB. Placed 31 sx (36 cuft) below the retainer and 20 sx (23.6 cuft) above the retainer. Top of cement is approximately 1104'. Spotted a balanced plug across the Kirtland - Ojo Alamo top from 1012' to 722' with 22 sx (26 cuft). Spotted a surface plug from 197' to surface with 20 sx (23.6 cuft). The hole was staying full. All cement was Type 5 neat cement. Removed the tubinghead. This location will be used for the Tsah Tah 11 #3R redrill so the P&A marker will be installed after the new well is completed.
