Burlington Resources requests permission to continue with the completion of the subject well without further cement remediation. The cement bond log indicates that cement bond varies throughout the production casing. There is good bond from TD (6720') to approx. 6000', with approx. 50% bond at the shoe of the 7", then ratty cement to TOC @ 200'. Any attempts to remediate would probably be unsuccessful, since it will be hard to establish any type of circulation and the squeeze wouldn't be effective. 12/22/08 called Troy Salyers (BLM) and received permission to continue without remediation at this time. CBL will be supplied to the BLM and OCD. ✓
