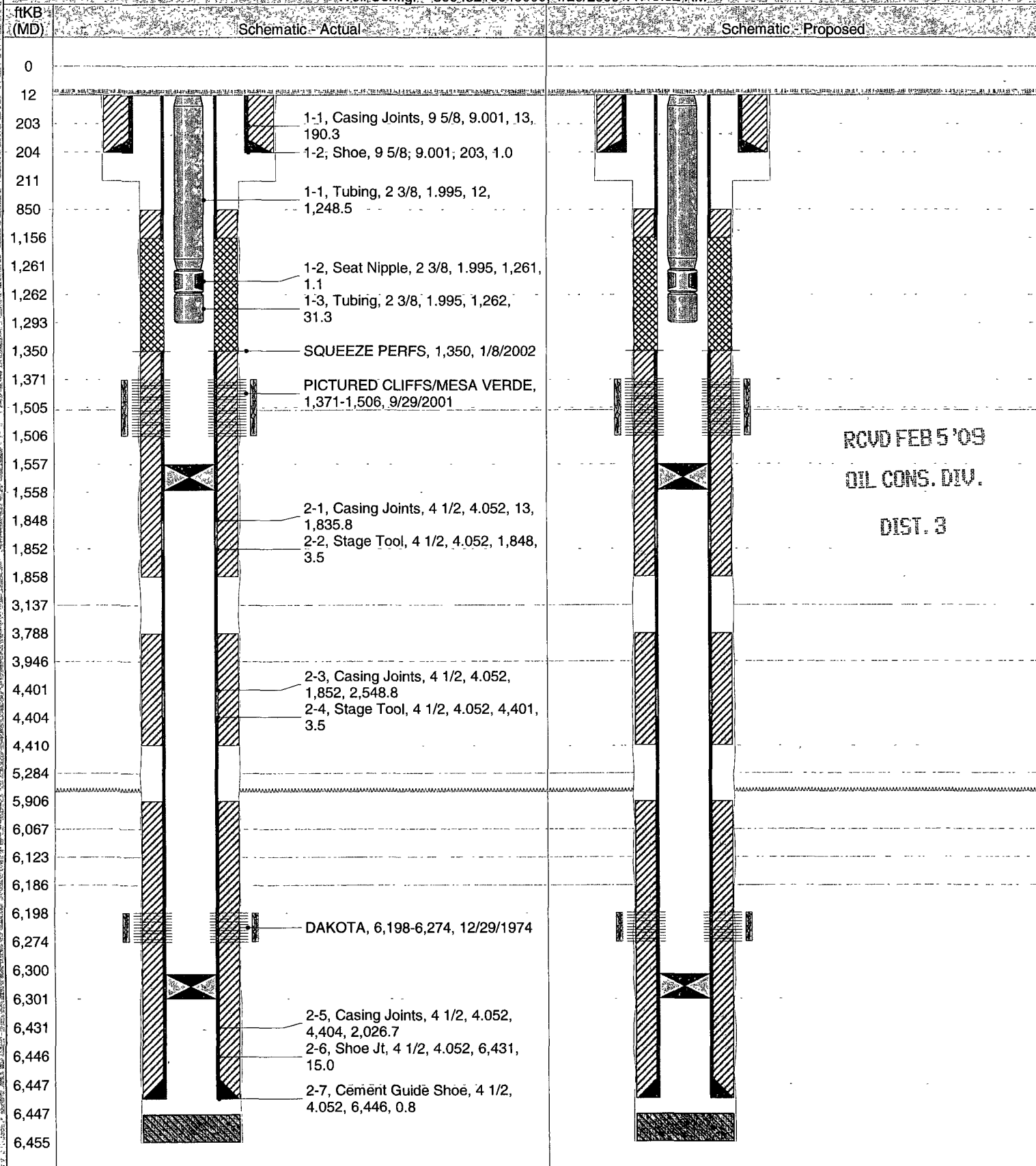

## **FINAL TEMPORARY ABANDONMENT APPROVAL**

### **CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL:**

1. This approval is for the Final Temporary Abandonment (TA) of this well. This approval is granted until January 20, 2010. This is twelve months from the submittal date. Before January 20, 2010, this well must be put back into production or permanently plugged. If Burlington Resources decides to plug and abandon this well, a Sundry Notice must be submitted and approved by this office prior to the plugging and abandonment.
2. No further TA requests for this well will be considered.
3. When this well is permanently plugged and abandoned, the existing CIBPs will have to be drilled out and new plugs set as per Onshore Order #2. These plugs will have to be set from 6300' to surface. An MIT will also have to be performed prior to abandonment operations to determine if remedial cementing is required.
