13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

Since historical contamination was found on this location when replacing old equipment COPC is going to have to remove the soils. Because of the existing layout of the well pad there isn't enough room on the pad to have the trucks turn around to leave the location. There is an abandon road going into this location that COPC wishes to use that will make it easier to access the location and allow us to work to remove the soils without turning the large trucks around to leave the location.

There is also a section of road approx. 300' from the location that is only approx. 10' wide that COPC would like to widen to 15' to allow room for the large truck to pass on this road without falling into the bar ditch. Any soils needed to reclaim the well pad and widen the road will be purchased from the nearby landowner, Mr. Schreiber.

3/6/09 Bill Liess gave COPC verbal approval to proceed with using the abandon road and widening the section of road 300' from the location with the understanding that if upon revisiting the location the BLM could require additional work on the road to meet their standards.
