On 10/1/08, the 7" intermediate csg valve was blown resulting in a drop in the 4-1/2" production csg pressure. Devon plans to MI a workover rig, pull the tbq, set a 4-1/2" BP above the MV perfs, locate the csg leak. & squeeze the leak as required. The cmt inside the 4-1/2" csg will then be drilled out to the BP & the csg leak pressure tested to 500 psi. Following a successful pressure test, the BP will then be drilled out, the well cleaned out to below the DK perfs. the production tbq run, & the well returned to production.
