Dear Charlie:

Reference is made to the sundries submitted to the BLM on May 11, 2009 in reference to the above referenced wells. Although General Minerals is the operator of record for the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“NMOCD”), our affiliate, Burlington Resources Oil & Gas Company LP (“Burlington”), is the record title owner to the applicable federal leases. Pursuant to BLM directive dated April 20, Burlington was required to submit procedures to plug and abandon the captioned wells by May 15, 2009, due to recurring failure by General Minerals Corp. (“GMC”) to comply with applicable rules and regulations.

Based on the NMOCD operatorship on file, Burlington has filed these three plug and abandon sundries with General Minerals as the operator. Once the noted procedures are reinstated by BLM, and no legal threat or challenge from GMC after reasonable notice and opportunity to object is received, Burlington will proceed with the plugging and abandonment work as soon thereafter as operationally feasible. Burlington reserves all available legal and administrative rights and remedies to recover its costs relating to such plugging and abandonment operations.
