Reference is made to the following:

(a) your application (**administrative application reference No. pKAA09-11060668**) submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (the Division) in Santa Fe, New Mexico on April 20, 2008, and

(b) the Division's records pertinent to this request.

XTO Energy, Inc. (XTO) [OGRID 5380] has requested to drill the above-referenced well at an unorthodox gas well location, described above in the caption of this letter. The S/2 of Section 14 will be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 320-acre, more or less, spacing unit in the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool (71629). This pool is governed by statewide Rule 15.10.B, which provides for 320-acre units, with wells located at least 660 feet from a unit outer boundary. This location is less than 660 feet from the northern unit boundary.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 and 4.12.A(2).

It is our understanding that you are seeking this location for topographic reasons.
