Reference is made to your Sundry notices dated November 1, 2008, change of operator from Koch Exploration to EnerVest Operating LLC. According to our records the following wells are operated by Burlington Resources Oil and Gas Company, LP (Burlington): Quinn 335, Quinn 338, Quinn 342, and the Oxnard 333.

Before we can process this operator change, this office will need to first have a change of operator from Burlington to Koch Exploration. If your records have information to the contrary, please provide it to our office for consideration. Enclosed is a copy of a sundry notice dated February 22, 2005 whereby Burlington is transferring operation for specific wells to Koch. The above referenced wells are not on that transfer list. Also, the Seymour 720S is under Communitization Agreement (CA) NMNM-87144. In lieu of a sundry notice a designation of successor operator will need to be filed pursuant to terms of the CA.
