

1.	Discovery of Archeological Resources in the Presence or Absence of Monitoring: If, prior to or during excavation work, items of archaeological, paleontological, or historic value are reported or discovered, or an unknown deposit of such items is disturbed, the operator will immediately cease excavation. The operator will then notify the Forest Service immediately and will not resume excavation until written approval is given by the authorized officer.
2.	Site Protection and Employee Education: The operator, all of their employees, contractors, and subcontractors will be informed that cultural resources are to be avoided by all personnel, vehicles, and equipment. The operator will notify all of their employees, contractors, and subcontractors that it is illegal to collect, damage, or disturb cultural resources.
	The operator shall be responsible for the protection of all identified cultural resources within the area which may be affected by their actions. In addition, the operator shall be liable for all damage or injury to the identified cultural resources caused by their actions.
3.	 Site Barrier: Temporary site protection barriers will be erected prior to any construction. The barriers will consist of the following (applicable when checked): No site protection barriers required. Wooden Survey Lathe: Spaced no more than 10 feet apart and marked with blue paint or blue flagging. T-posts: Spaced no more than 10 feet apart. Wire is not required, but should be smooth wire if used. Mark posts and wire with blue flagging. Concrete Barriers: Placed in continuous line. cultural resources, work in the vicinity of the discovery will be suspended and the discover
promptly reported to the Forest Service.

Monitoring is Required:

It is the operator's responsibility to provide a copy of these stipulations and the IS &A to the archeological monitor prior to the scheduled pre-construction meeting. Fences and/or barriers must be in place prior to the scheduled pre-construction meeting. Protective barrier placement may be completed by the archeologist, or under the direction of the archeologist.

No construction activities, including vegetation removal, may begin before the arrival of the archeological monitor.

- 1. Restrict construction zone at Corner 6 to 25 feet.
- 2. Existing T-post fence at Corner 6 to be replaced with concrete barriers. Barriers to be placed along outer edge of restricted construction zone, extending approximately 40 meters west of the revised construction zone corner and approximately 25 meters southeast of the revised construction zone corner. Barriers to extend from southeast end to outer edge of construction zone as shown on attached map. Archeologist to direct placement of barriers.
- 3. Archeologist to monitor all ground-disturbing activities within 100 feet of site.

The monitor will submit a report of the monitoring activities <u>within 30 days</u> of completion of monitoring unless other arrangements are made with the Forest Service. A copy of these stipulations must be attached to the monitor report.
