Closed-looped Design Plan for the Post Federal 13#6

In accordance with Rule 19.15.17 NMAC the following information describes the design of a close-looped system for Black Hills Gas Resources (BHGR). The following describes BHGR standard procedures for a close-looped system, a separate plan will be submitted for any close-looped system which does not conform to this plan

BHGR closed-loop system will not require a drying pad, temporary pit, below grade tank or a sump. It will include an above ground steel tank suitable for holding the cuttings and fluids for rig operations. The tank will be of sufficient volume to maintain a safe free board between disposal of the liquids and solids from the rig operations.

- Fencing is not required for an above ground closed-loop system.
- BHGR will post a well sign in compliance with 19.15.3.103 NMAC.
- BHGR will place frac tank on location to store fresh water.

Operating and Maintenance Plan (O&M)

BHGR's closed-loop system will be operated and maintained to contain liquids and solids to prevent contamination of fresh water sources, to protect public health and the environment. BHGR O&M plan will include the following steps:

- BHGR will vacuum out the liquids, which will be disposed of at T-N-T Environmental facility (Permit# NM 01-8-0). Solids in the closed-loop tank will be vacuumed out and disposed of at T-N-T Environmental facility (Permit# NM 01-8-0) on a periodic basis to prevent over flow.
- No Hazardous waste, miscellaneous solid waste, or debris will be stored in the tank. Only fluids or cuttings, used or generate by rig operations, will be placed or stored in the tank.
- BHGR will notify the Aztec district office within 48 hours, if a discovery of the closed-loop system's integrity is compromised in any way. Upon a discovery of a compromised tank, repairs will be made immediately.
- During rig operations a daily inspection will be conducted, which will be logged, signed, and dated.

Clósure Plan

The closed-loop system will be closed within 60 days of completion, and in accordance with Subsection D of 19.15.17.13. This will be done by transporting the cuttings, remaining sludge and all remaining liquid to the T-N-T Environmental facility (Permit# NM 01-8-0). The tank will be removed from the location as part of the rig mob. If any equipment is set off location, BHGR will re-seed the disturbed area. Also as part of the abandonment of the well, the location will be re-contoured and re-vegetated to pre-existing conditions when possible.
