ConocoPhillips Company installed a Frac valve and PT the subject well. Had 85' of cmt to clean out. C/O cmt and then PT csg. Could pressure up to 900# w/ no leak off, but started leaking & couldn't test. C/O to PBTD @ 7735'. Re-logged well & found bad collar @ 7646', which is in the DK pay zone. Set RBP @ 7630' and conducted PT of 1500#/30min. Test - OK. ✓ 4 1/2" csg set @ 7737'. Top of formations: Two Wells - 7528', Cabero - 7636' & Lower Cabero - 7660'. The DK perforation will begin just below 7528' and continue to 7660'. ConocoPhillips notified agencies on 9/29/09 and requests the well be completed without remediation since the leak is in the Dakota pay zone. ✓ The log is attached. ✓
