Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* **A ConocoPhillips Company employee discovered a produced water spill of approximately 20 BBL at the San Juan 27-4 #47P on the morning of 7/19/08 due to a tank overfilling. The pit ran over due to increased production of liquids. Upon discovery, the employee shut in the well and called a water hauler to pull the standing fluids.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\* **All of the spilled fluids were contained within the berm, and 18 BBL of produced water were recovered by vacuum truck. The affected soils will be monitored to determine if further remediation is necessary. To prevent reoccurrence, COPC will monitor fluids levels in the tanks.**
