


Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* **A ConocoPhillips employee discovered a release of approximately 406 MCF of natural gas at the Charles Et Al #1 on the morning of 6/23/08 due to a leak in the pipe running from the wellhead to the meter house. Upon discovery, the employee shut in the well and walked the pipeline. The employee discovered an area of approximately 40' x 40' of dead vegetation approximately 100 feet from Blanco Wash.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **Upon investigation, the employee discovered that the soil underneath the dead vegetation was impacted by hydrocarbons. COPC installed groundwater monitoring wells and took soil samples to assess the extent of the impact. At this time, it was determined that the affected area is localized around where the gas was released from the pipe. Four temporary groundwater wells were installed and soil samples were collected. The results of the groundwater and soil sampling are pending lab analysis. COPC will continue to monitor the affected area to determine if any further remediation is necessary.**
