


Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* **A ConocoPhillips employee discovered a spill of approximately 7.9 BBL of produced water at the Marx Fed #1 on the afternoon of 6/26/08 due to a leak in the condensate production tank. Upon discovery, the employee shut in the well and called Western Refining to pull the condensate from the tank.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\* **All of the spilled fluids were contained within the berm, but none were recovered. The tank has been replaced. The affected soils were raked and will be monitored to determine if further remediation is necessary. Asset and Operating Integrity will examine the tank to determine the cause of the leak. To prevent reoccurrence, COPC employees will continue to perform monthly inspections of the production tanks.**
