


**Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\***

A fire was discovered off of the ounce regulator on the pumping unit fuel pot at the subject location at approximately 9:15 am on 9/22/09. The small fire was extinguished by shutting off the fuel source. Investigations point to the possibility of the ounce regulator leaking gas and igniting from the exhaust or engine components.

**Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*** Fire was confined to the area near the fuel pot on the pumping unit.
