

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* **On March 24, 2009, a COPC MSO discovered that the water pit tank had a leak possibly due to corrosion & approximately 5 BBL produced water was released. Upon discovery, the MSO shut in the well & notified Western to pull the tank. All spilled fluids remained in the berm.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\* **All of the spilled fluids remained on location in the berm. The spill impacted soil on the ground surface in the pit. The water pit tank was removed and soils were excavated by M&M Trucking. Approximately 882 yd3 of impacted soil was excavated. The soil was hauled to Industrial Ecosystem's Incorporated landfarm. Approximately 660 yd3 of clean backfill was brought back to the location for facility reset. Envirotech completed the conformation sampling to confirm that all impacted soil was excavated. To prevent reoccurrence, COPC will continue to perform tank inspections.**
