Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* ☐ During a routine site visit an XTO operator discovered all four produced water tanks overflowing into the berm. The well was shut in, a vac truck and roustabout crew was called. Upon investigation it was discovered that the unit had gone down due to heat but there was a system failure at this location. The system has been turning itself off and has to be re-booted manually. The system had shut itself off the day before at 4:30 PM and the re-boot was never done. There were no call out alarms in the night to notify personnel of the overflowing tanks. Approximately 480 barrels of fruitland coal produced water was released and contained within the berm. Vac trucks recovered approximately 478 barrels. The system manufacturer and local personnel are correcting the problem.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\* ☐ A vac truck was used to recover water from the lined bermed area.
