

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* **A ConocoPhillips Company MSO (lease operator) discovered a crude oil / paraffin spill of approximately 25 BBL at the San Juan 29-7 Unit #88A on the morning of 1/23/08, due to a release from the dump controllers on the separator and also a stuffing box leak around the wellhead. This occurred due to the line from the wellhead to the tank freezing, and so the stuffing box leaked around the wellhead. It also appears that the well unloaded up the casing but the fire had gone out on the separator, thus spilling out of the dump controllers around the separator. Upon discovery, the well and pumping unit were shut in, and the impacted soil was fenced off. All spilled fluids remained on location, and 17 BBL was recovered by vacuum truck.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\* **All spilled fluids remained on location, and 17 BBL was recovered by vacuum truck. Excavation of the remaining impacted soils for remediation is scheduled to begin on Monday, 1/28/08, with the soils being hauled offsite to a commercial landfarm. A final report will be sent upon the completion of remediation activities.**
