

If a Watercourse was Impacted, Describe Fully.* **The drilling fluids (mostly fresh water w/ some FC produced water used in underreaming) potentially ran off location due to a rain water runoff pattern visually observed across location. There is a wash which flows intermittently during rain events. There was no staining or evidence of a spill due to the heavy rains.**

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* **During cavitation/cleanout operations on the San Juan 30-6 Unit #458, the lined reserve pit potentially overflowed an unknown amount of drilling fluids due to heavy rains and potentially ran off location. There is a wash which flows intermittently during rain events. There was no staining or evidence of a spill due to the heavy rains. Because the rig was idle and unmanned for several days due to road access problems, the exact date of the pit overflowing is unknown but could have occurred between 7/23/07 and 8/6/07.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **There was no staining or evidence of a spill, so no remediation is required. To prevent this from happening in the future, the rig pits will be enlarged when there is question of volume capacity to allow for freeboard and diversions will also be built as necessary.**
