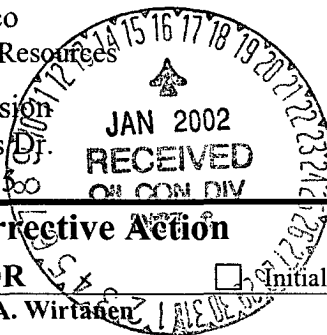

The cause of this spill was the transfer charge pump would not auto start because of a bad battery. The bermed area was intact and no water left the bermed area on location. Key Energy sucked up the water if could and will dispose of it properly. Approx. 60 bbls was recovered and the water will be taken to Basin Disposal.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Spilled produced water did not leave location, and once the water as sucked up was hauled off, no further action was taken to remediate.
