

If a Watercourse was Impacted, Describe Fully.*

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* **A spill occurred at the Canyon Largo Unit #286E on 6/4/07. The spill is estimated to be less than 2 BBL frac water (with corrosion inhibitor, soap, foamer) and a small amount of produced oil. The spill was from overspray from the bloolie line to the flare pit due to there not being enough gas to flare the gas and fluids, and windy conditions preventing the pilot from lighting, thus causing the overspray. The spill sprayed off location in a fine mist impacting adjacent soils, brush, and trees. This was reported immediately by our rig completions staff to our construction staff when it occurred, but the communication stopped there which is the reason for the late report.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **The spill sprayed off location in a fine mist impacting adjacent soils, brush, and trees. For remediation, the brush and trees will be sprayed with Simple Green and the impacted soils around the brush and trees will be raked. The soil in the flare pit is being analyzed for DRO/GRO to confirm the absence or presence of hydrocarbons before the flare pit is covered back in. If hydrocarbons are present, the impacted soil will be hauled offsite to a commercial landfarm.**
