Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

A groundwater impact was discovered following installation, sampling and receipt of laboratory test reports for a groundwater monitor well at the site of a prior steel tank pit. Impacts unknown until receipt of laboratory reports on 12/13/07. Impacts appear to be limited to dissolved phase in groundwater.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Further investigation is required to determine areal extent, but initial investigation indicates impacts limited to groundwater at immediate pit tank area only. (Correspondence dated 12/13/07 submitted to NMOCD Aztec and Santa Fe offices confirming notification of release and pending investigation)
