Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*☐ A leak in a water tank was discovered by an XTO lease operator while gauging the tank. Once the leak was discovered all proper notifications were made. Upon investigation it appeared the leak was coming from the bottom of the tank. Approximately 38 barrels of produced water was released. All water was contained within the berm and did not leave location. The tank was immediately drained and evacuated.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*☐ The produced water was removed from the berm. Blagg Engineering was contacted to test soil and oversee clean up. There were no hydrocarbons detected. Soil was excavated and raked. A new steel tank was installed.
