

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* **A ConocoPhillips Company MSO (lease operator) discovered a lube oil spill of an estimated 11 BBL at the twinned wellpad of the Scott #2R and Scott #101 on the afternoon of 10/24/07, as a result of holes being shot in the lube oil day tank due to vandalism. All fluids were contained on location and immediately diked up to prevent any further horizontal migration. A truck was also immediately dispatched to pick up the free standing lube oil, of which 10 BBL was recovered from the ground.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **All fluids were contained on location and immediately diked up to prevent any further horizontal migration. A truck was also immediately dispatched to pick up the free standing lube oil, of which 10 BBL was recovered from the ground. The remaining impacted soils were excavated and approximately 10 cubic yards were hauled off-site on 10/25/07 to a commercial landfarm for remediation.**
