

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* **A ConocoPhillips MSO discovered a crude oil spill of 60 BBL at the San Juan 32-9 Unit #5R on 7/24/07, that occurred when the weir nipple of the separator became plugged, sending all of the fluid to the oil production tank which overfilled resulting in the spill. All fluids were contained within the bermed area, with 50 BBL recovered by a vacuum truck.**
