Broken pipe caused water to spill out on ground. Vacuum truck called to vacuum pooled water & recovered 20 bbls and was placed into disposal tank for injection. Spill contained for remediation.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
Spill was on flat surface, 90% of spill was on location, 10% re-seeded with Great West Reclamation. Soils remediated with construction crew. Damaged pipe repaired with roustabout crew.
