
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.

Due to muddy road conditions, water hauling driver with SSS Trucking temporarily drop pup on well location over night. Drain valve not locked out and improperly secured, and load drained by unknown individual (vandalism). Release contained to location, attempt made to recover standing water.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.

Request incident investigation and update to water hauling procedures to ensure loads properly secured when not delivered to disposal in a timely manner. No further action being taken at this time.
