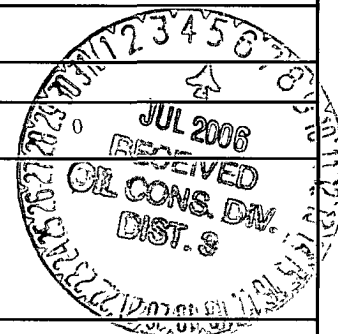

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken *

A 1" blowdown valve on the tubing was unexplainably open allowing Fruitland Coal produced water to spray out as the pumping well produced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Most of the water stayed on location and soaked into the ground. Some water did travel approximately 40 yards off location (damp path 1-2 ft wide), but did not go into any wash. The impacted soils will be raked upon drying to break up any crust that may form.
