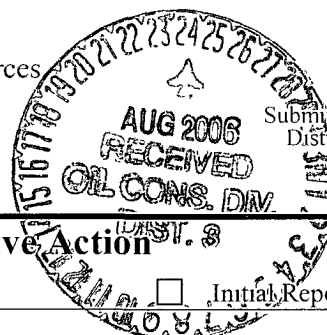

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken * <input type="checkbox"/> A faulty ignition switch and wiring on the pumping unit motor caused the pit tank to overflow resulting in a spill of approximately 20 bbl of clear produced water. The spill was contained within the secondary containment structure, the water clear without sheen of hydrocarbon on the water. No further remedial action is recommended at this time.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken * <input type="checkbox"/> There did not appear to be lateral migration of the spill beyond the secondary containment. The spill was detected promptly and a vacuum truck immediately recovered the water within the berm walls. Quick response resulted in recovery of water and no observed impact to the location.
