Our records indicate that you are the operator of the following wells:

1) No. 476 Canyon Largo Unit, 1310' FNL & 1665' FEL sec. 26, T. 24 N., R. 6 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, Lease NMSF-078925. Well has not produced since October, 2008.

2) No. 477 Canyon Largo Unit, 1060' FNL & 860' FEL sec. 27, T. 24 N., R. 6 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, Lease NMSF-078925. Well has not produced since October, 2008.

Title 43 CFR Section 3162.3-4 requires that the lessee shall promptly plug and abandon, condition as a service well, or condition as a water well, any well on a lease that is not used or useful for the purpose of the lease.
