

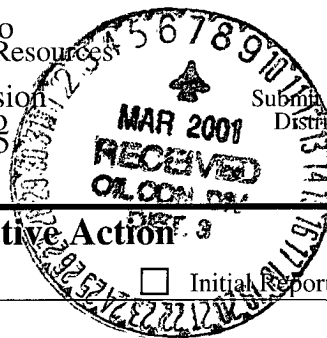

ALL FLUID WAS CONTAINED INSIDE BERM, EXCEPT 2GALS OIL AND 10GALS WATER (ESTIMATED) AREA OUTSIDE THE BERM WAS 10'X10'. COMTAMIATED SOIL WILL BE REMOVED AND LANDFARMED ON LOCATION. SAMPLES WILL BE TAKEN TO DETERMINE THE EXTEND AND DEPTH OF COMTAMIATION. ON-SITE TECHNOLOGY WILL ASSIST IN THE REMEDIATION OF THE SITE.
