DETAILS OF WORK

Spudding Date - August 15, 1952, 5:30 P.M.

After drilling a 6 3/4-inch hole to 102 feet below the floor of 40-inch cellar, 99 feet of 15# 5 1/2-inch casing was ran to 102 1/2 feet. Cement was circulated thru and around this casing and allowed to set for 22 hours. On the evening of Aug. 17th, the plug was drilled out of the bottom of the casing and the rams closed on the blowout preventer. Pressure was built up to 700# with the mud pump and held for 15 minutes. A total loss of 20#. This loss is believed to have been thru the mud pump and fittings to the hole.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
