13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

ConocoPhillips requests permission to abandon the Dakota formation for the subject well due to drilling issues. The production casing string is stuck at 8150', which is 200' from the TD of 8328'. Notified agencies of stuck pipe and received approval from BLM (Troy Salyers) and OCD (Kelly Roberts) to move the drilling rig off the subject location and bring a completion rig on within a timely manner with 2 3/8" capability to pump a 500' balanced plug from 7624' - 8154'. Set a CIBP @ 6450' and shoot squeeze holes at 6400' and attempt to squeeze cement a 100' inside the 7" shoe. Permission was granted on 6/16/10 from BLM at 2:20pm and OCD at 3:32pm to proceed.
