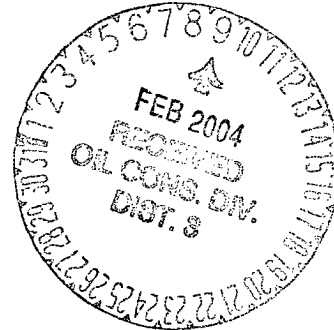

Reference is made to your Application for Permit to Drill (APD) the No. 1E Pork Chop Federal 28 well, located 1930' FNL and 660' FWL, Section 28, T26N, R7W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.
