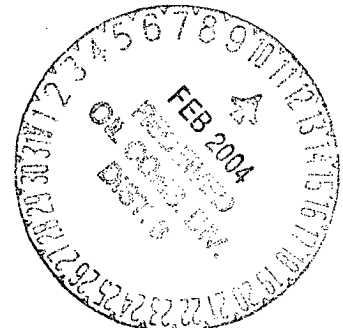

The Cowsaround #2-14R was completed in November of 1998, but production fell from 45 MCFD to 3 MCFD over the first six months. The well hasn't produced anything since June of 2001. Running Horse Production Company LLC recently took over operatorship of this well and we respectfully request time to evaluate the economic alternatives for this well.
