This well has been non-productive since Dec. 2009. While reviewing historic data (pre-work for well restoration) it was found that on 2-18-2004 a pump was stuck open & tubing was unable to be landed in the Dakota formation. Below is submitted For Record Clean Up Purposes:

2/17/2004 Clean out to PBDT @6027'. TIH land Tbg @5880'. Test tbg to 500 psi; held 5 min. Good Test. Long stroke pmp to 800 psi - Good Test.

2/18/2004 Hang on horses head, start motor, put on down stroke, hang rods on, run jack & check for tag. On the 3rd stroke pump stuck open. Rig down horses head, long stroke pump with rig - no good. Decision was made to TOH; & land tbg @1400' in order to pump off the Fruitland Coal.

2/19/2004 TOH; lay down tbg; TIH & land 2 3/8"; 4.7#; J-55 tbg @1396'. RD MO Location.

Rig never returned to the well and tubing was left at 1396'. Pump remains stuck and well work is needed to restore well to production. It is suspected that the Dakota is sanded up and unable to produce.

Procedure or subsequent report will follow when engineers determine how best to restore well to production.
