

Take Hwy 550 (south) for 1.0 miles to CR 4900 turn left (easterly) on CR 4900 15.0 miles to 5 Mile Bridge, stay right @ intersection (southeasterly) for 3.2 miles, across 10 mile bridge continue (southeasterly) 18.2 miles to Old Largo Canyon School, Turn right (southeasterly), along Canyon Largo Wash 2.5 miles, turn left (easterly) across Largo Wash 2.8 miles, Turn hard right (westerly) 1.6 miles, To the top of Gonzales Mesa, Continue along road (southeast) 2.1 miles, Turn right (southwest) 0.2 miles, Continue (southerly) 0.5 miles, to beginning of new access on left side of road, turn left (southeast) 547.72' to the newly staked location twinned with existing location, CANYON LARGO UNIT #292F.
