Site Security Plan for McElvain Oil and Gas Properties, Inc.

This plan is to be maintained at at McElvain's office in Denver, Colorado. The address is 1050 17th Street, Suite 1800, Denver Colorado, 80265. The telephone number is 303-893-0933. A copy of this plan is also at 2346 East 20th Street at the office of Joe Elledge. That phone number is 505-327-9267.

INITIAL INSPECTION PROGRAM

An initial inspection has been made of these facilities to insure that all the provisions have been adhered to.

SELF INSPECTION PROGRAM

Monthly inspections will be performed and a record of any problems found will be maintained and corrected. The inspection will consist of verifying tank gauges, inspection of tank seals, a check of the gas meter and an inspection of the production equipment for safe and proper operation.

SEALS AND RUN TICKETS

The pumper will keep a record of seals removed and installed and the reason for such action on the current monthly gauge and book report. These records will be retained for a period of six years at the main office.

The transporter/purchaser shall complete a run ticket prior to removing any oil from the lease. The run ticket shall include the name of the seller, the well name, the lease number, the location of the tank (quarter/quarter section, section, township, and range), the date, tank number, tank capacity, opening and closing gauges with temperature, number of seal removed, number of seal installed, observed gravity, BS&W, signature of gauger and the pumper.

THEFT/MISHANDLING OF OIL

Incidents of theft or mishandling of oil well be reported to the Bureau of Land Management district office on the next business day after the discovery. A written report will be filed within ten business days. The report will contain the following information: Company name, name of person making report, well name, lease number, location being reported (quarter/quarter section, section, township, range), estimated volumes involved, description of what happened, the individual who discovered the incident, the date and time of discovery, and local law enforcement agencies that were notified.

WELL IDENTIFICATION

The well site will be clearly identified with a sign that contains the operator, lease number, section, township, range, county, state and the well name and number.

OIL STORAGE FACILITIES

All storage facilities will be clearly identified with the assigned tank number, and all vacuum and pressure seals will be in place.

Accumulation of oil will be sold in a timely manner.

SITE FACILITY DIAGRAM

A current site facility diagram has been filed with the Bureau of Land Management in Albuquerque, New Mexico.

All new facilities will have a site security plan submitted within thirty days of final construction.
