

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* During maintenance activities, a historical earthen pit was discovered at the Elliott Annie LB #6E well site. The site was then ranked pursuant to the NMOCD Guidelines for the Remediation of Leaks, Spills and Releases. The site was ranked a 0, setting the closure standard to 5,000 ppm TPH, 10 ppm benzene and 50 ppm total BTEX. All soil above these standards will be removed and hauled to Envirotech's Landfarm for disposal.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Cleanup activities are currently underway. A final C-141 with closure samples will follow upon completion of excavation activities.
