At Brandon Powell's suggestion Envirotech is providing written notice of the actions taken concerning the Richardson Operating waste from the Fruitland Compressor Station.

On November 30, 2006 Brandon Powell of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) Aztec office directed Envirotech to segregate the Richardson Operating material that was denied acceptance by the Environmental Bureau. With NMOCD's verbal approval the material had been moved to the Landfarm and stabilized on November 17, 2006.

Upon receiving the denial from the Santa Fe office on November 30, 2006, Envirotech immediately located the material in the remediation unit and marked it for removal. On December 1, 2006 the material was moved to an isolated lined, bermed area. The material is available for sampling at your request. Upon completion of the transfer, we immediately notified Mr. Powell. Mr. Powell has documented this contaminated material with photos.
