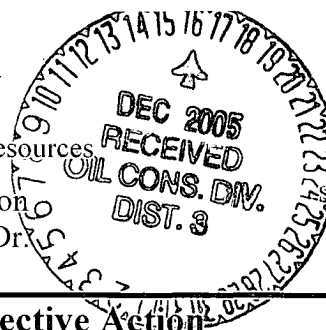

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* **A spill of at least 40 BBL of produced water with a skim of oil floating on top occurred at the San Juan 31-6 Unit #202 on 12/6/05, when a produced water tank ran over due to tank trucks overfilling the tanks. (Williams disposes of produced water at the #202 which is then pipelined to ConocoPhillips' San Juan 31-6 Unit #301 SWD.) The high level shut down on the tanks also failed to work. All spilled fluids remained within the bermed area and 40 BBL were recovered by vacuum truck.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **All spilled fluids remained within the bermed area and 40 BBL were recovered by vacuum truck. For remediation purposes, the oil stained rocks surrounding the tanks will be removed.**
