A dump valve stuck causing produced water to produce into the condensate tank. The high level shutdown switch failed and the condensate storage tank overflowed into the bermed area.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
All fluids were contained inside the bermed area. Free liquids were recovered using a vacuum truck. Impacted soils were raked / mixed with clean soils to promote natural remediation.
