



Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* A produced water spill of 40 BBL was discovered on Saturday morning, 12/11/04 by the lease operator. The well had just been turned on after a recompletion on Friday, 12/10/04 at 10:00 a.m. and was making a lot of water. A contract water truck failed to pull a load from the 45 BBL pit tank on Friday, and it overflowed 40 BBL into the bermed area. All 40 BBL was recovered. The water hauling company was contacted to ensure they would check the well daily and pull the water, so the well was kept on and flowing. Another 10 BBL spill from this same pit tank was then discovered on Monday morning, 12/13/04 by the lease operator. Apparently, the water hauler went to this location late Saturday/early Sunday, but looked at the wrong pit tank for pulling. All of the water was contained within the bermed area, and 10 BBL was recovered with a vacuum truck. The well is now shut in until a larger tank can be installed on location.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\* No water left the berm. All spilled fluids were recovered (50 BBL). The well has been shut in until a larger tank can be installed on location. This will be the final report.
