

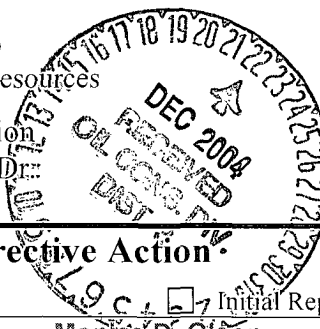

If a Watercourse was Impacted, Describe Fully.*

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* **A condensate/oil spill of 27 BBL occurred on Friday afternoon 12/17/04. A Giant transport truck overfilled when both the high level kill and warning malfunctioned, and the driver did not realize the truck was full. From the tank gauges, Giant calculated they lost 27 BBL of oil on the ground. Giant personnel initially recovered as much as they could (4 BBL), then put down 57 bags of peat moss to absorb the rest and contain it for the night. Denny Foust with NMOCD was notified by Giant. Attempts were also made on Saturday to contact the surface owner, Leo Pacheco, to advise him of the situation.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **The spill affected the soil to a depth of approximately 6". The snow cover on the ground melted, spreading the spill to an area about 40' x 15' (see attached diagram). An emergency one-call was performed on Saturday morning, 12/18/04, and the well was shut in. Remediation continued on Saturday, when approximately 80 cubic yards of stained soil was excavated and taken to the Mid-Continent landfarm on the Bisti Highway. Following soil sampling on Monday 12/20/04, the area will be backfilled with clean soil. This will be the final report.**
